COVID Safe Update – Thank you for your assistance in what has been an interesting year. We have updated our COVID guidelines to align with the Field Sports Industry Plan. The principals of stage 2 still apply (Stay at home if sick or have symptoms, Attendance at the Club is to be registered, Players will train in zones to limit co-mingling of groups, Parents and spectators are to socially distance). Under Stage 3 we are able to open the bar on a Friday night and will use the EVA App (a QR code reader) to record attendance at the Club. **Please Checkout of the App when leaving.** Player or on field spectator attendance will be registered via a paper system managed by team coaches. At this Stage there will be no BBQ.

Note if you are following last years team you need to unfollow Riverside and save.

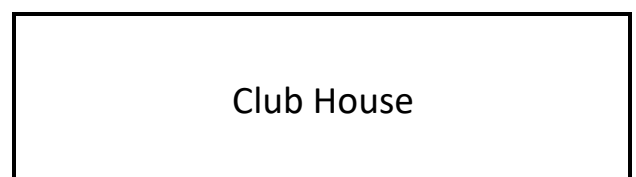
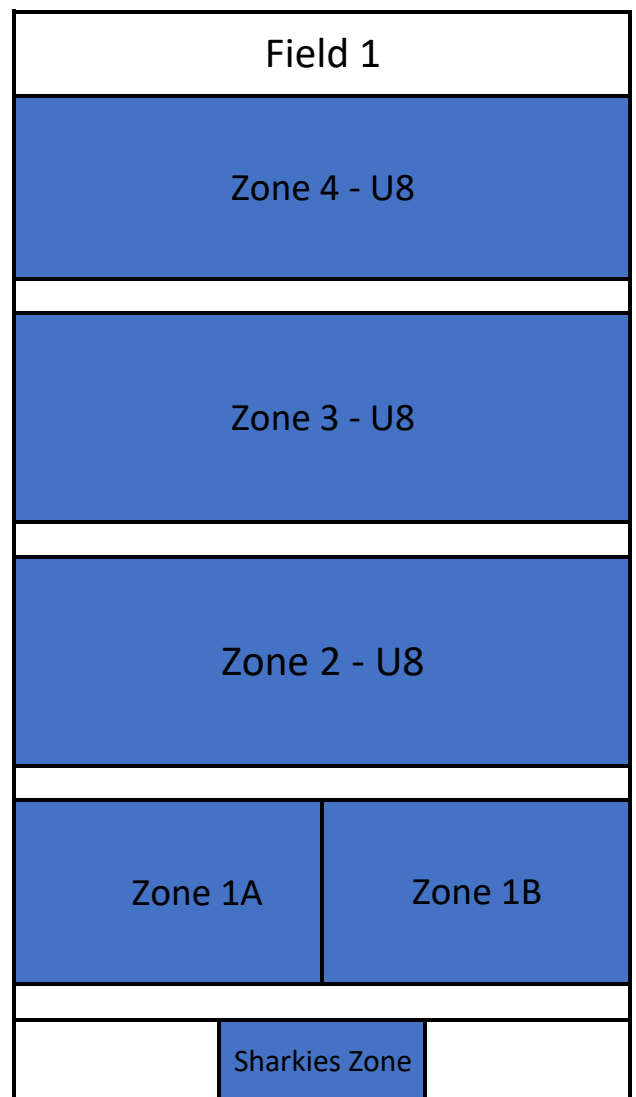

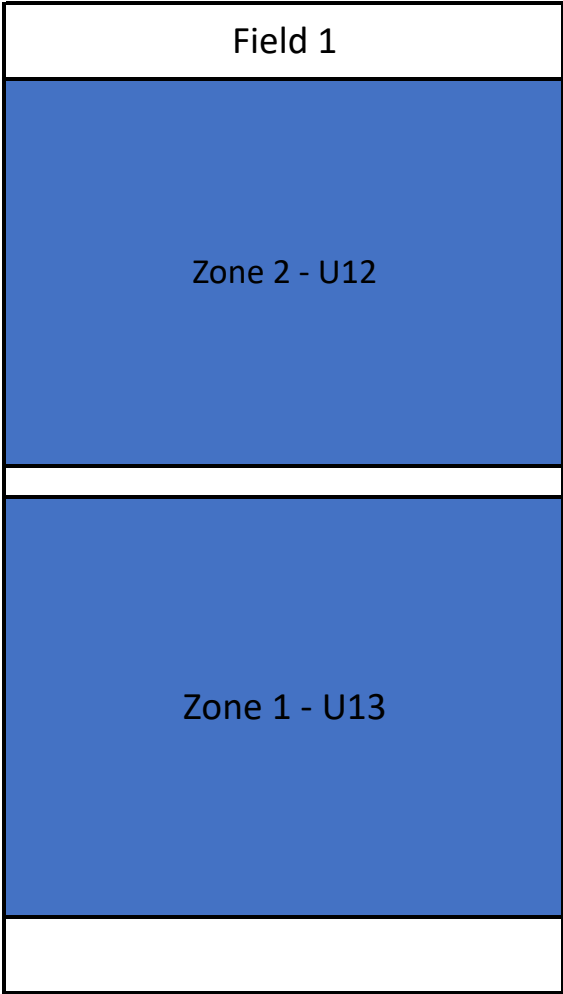

Training Map Wednesday Nights



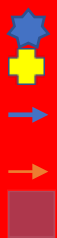
Guidelines for COVIDSafe Training & GAMES

- Zones per field will be adjusted to suit games or training activities but 4m² per person will be maintained
- All players and coaches must enter and exit via the allocated paths for each training / playing zone and complete registration details – at Sanitation Station on each zone. Coach shall have prepopulated register for each team and mark attendance details
- At check-in each person will be asked:
 - Are you feeling unwell with symptoms such as fever, sore throat, cough or shortness of breath?
 - Have you had close contact* with someone who has a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19)? -face-to-face contact for more than 15 minutes or have shared an enclosed space for more than two hours.
 - Have you travelled overseas in the last 14 days?
 - Did you travel outside of Queensland in the last 14 days?
- Do not attend the training / playing session if the answer to any of the above questions is 'yes'.
- If any person answers yes to the above questions, they will not be permitted to enter the exclusion zone or train/play and will need to remain in the marked "Isolation area" until collected by a parent. (Masks and Gloves are provided & to be used)
- If during training/playing anyone advises they have any of above listed symptoms there should be taken to marked "Isolation area". (Masks and Gloves are provided & to be used)
- Only players & coaches are permitted within the exclusion zone for Training sessions
- Spectators/Parents/Siblings are allowed during Game days around playing area – contact details shall be registered of ALL Participants using either a APP called "EVA" on phone or paper based – they should maintain social distancing at 1.5M where possible
- During Training any Spectators/Parents/Siblings should remain in Parent Zone around clubhouse/Bar area - contact details shall be registered of ALL Participants using either a APP called "EVA" on phone or paper based – they should maintain social distancing at 1.5M where possible
- Coaches to clean balls and equipment after training – If any Balls to go into other training zones they should be cleaned before being re-used
- Parents are encouraged where possible to STOP, DROP and GO and collect children at the end of the training session
- Bar shall NOW be open on most Training nights, the BBQ and Food will not be opened at this stage in Level 3 restrictions.
